COMMENTS AND/CONCERNS OF CITIZENS PRESENT: Trey Waldofsky, 295 E. Fitchburg Rd., Leslie spoke on behalf of the Leslie soccer program. Their concerns about the circus using the soccer field are the possibility of damage to the field (large stakes, trucks, and animals), safety and the timing of having the field in playable condition by August.

Rashawna Swichtenberg, 109 N. Sherman St., Leslie asked the Board for permission to decorate their graduation caps next year. She has a petition with 240 signatures of others who agree.

Ted Urban, 3161 Tuttle Rd., Leslie spoke on behalf of the Leslie Chamber of Commerce. The soccer field site was selected because of its proximity to downtown Leslie. He spent a day with the company talking

about the set up and tear down of the circus. He was assured that the field will be left in the same condition as it was found.

Deann Maynard 4747 Jackson Rd., Leslie mentioned that CASL tryouts will begin June 25th through the 30th. In addition, the high school soccer teams play informally on that field all summer. Any damage to the field will make it unavailable for practice.

Jennifer Austin, 12013 Country River Dr., Rives Junction, asked the board keep the safety of the soccer players in mind. She is worried about the condition of the soccer field after a circus has been there.

BOARD DISCUSSION AND/OR ACTION: Fifth grade teacher Laura Fenger talked about the 30 students she has in the Gifted and Talented program. She gave an overview how these students are identified and how their learning projects are chosen.

Business Manager Anita Strong presented a draft 2016-2017 budget. The proposed per pupil foundation for the 2016-17 school year is \$7,511. The budget is based on 1,270 students. A revised draft budget will be distributed at the June 13, 2016 Board meeting. Board approval of the budget will be at the Truth In Taxation special board meeting on June 27, 2016.

Committee members of the Residents for the Growth of Leslie Public Schools will be walking in the Memorial Day parade. Discussion ensued about getting information to community members. Supt. Manthei will have a drop-down link to sinking fund information put on the Leslie Public Schools website. The next meeting is Monday, June 6 at 7:00 p.m. at the Leslie Fire Barn.
