Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

Woodworth Elementary (PreK - 4): At Woodworth Elementary we have continued to offer a hybrid of in-person and online learning options for all students. In-person instruction is provided 4 days each week, with 1 day of distance/remote learning. Online instruction is provided 5 days each week for our virtual learners. During the week of March 26 - April 1, 2021, all students transitioned to virtual learning due to a recent spike in positive cases within the district.

Leslie Middle School (5 - 8): At LMS we have continued to offer a hybrid of in-person and online learning options for all students. In-person instruction is provided 4 days each week, with 1 day of distance/remote learning. Online instruction is provided 5 days each week for our virtual learners. During the week of March 26 - April 1, 2021, all students transitioned to virtual learning due to a recent spike in positive cases within the district.

Leslie High School (9 - 12): At LHS we have continued to offer a hybrid of in-person and online learning options for all students. In-person instruction is provided 4 days each week, with 1 day of distance/remote learning. Online instruction is provided 5 days each week for our virtual learners. During the week of March 26 - April 1, 2021, all students transitioned to virtual learning due to a recent spike in positive cases within the district.

Additional support is available on distance learning days for students to work individually or in small groups with teachers/staff at each building.
