Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:

Leslie Public Schools continues to provide students and families an option to receive instruction in-person or online to the extent feasible with state mandates and staffing.

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services mandated that all high schools in the state move to distant learning November 18 through December 9, 2020. As a result of the state order, our high school students in grades 9-12 have received instruction virtually and/or through a combination of packet learning provided to students weekly with feedback.

Additionally, due to a transportation staffing shortage, students PreK-8 transitioned to distant learning for the week of November 30 through December 4, 2020. Virtual instruction was provided during this time for those with adequate technology, packet instruction was distributed with instruction as needed. All teachers provided instructional support during distant learning periods.
