#### **School Bond Refinance**

On October 7, 2019 the Leslie Board of Education voted to refinance the 2008 school bond. This process is very similar to homeowners refinancing a mortgage. The purpose of refinancing a bond is to save money over the length of the bond. The difference between a bond and a mortgage is that when a bond is refinanced, the savings pass back to the taxpayers.

Prior to refinancing the bond, the interest rate was 4%. After refinancing, the interest rate was lowered to 1.92%. Due to the lower interest rate, the savings is \$115,000. The savings will be spread out to all taxpayers in the Leslie School District.

Refinancing the bond does not lengthen the term of the bond and will still be paid in full in 2025.

Woodworth Elementary School The 2019-2020 school year has taken off in a very positive way! We have fully implemented our Tier 1 Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) in an effort to institute positive recognition for those students who meet school-wide expectations. Teachers are working to meet individual students' needs with regard to behavioral supports through the use of our Behavior Matrix. This matrix includes receiving STAR tickets with plans for weekly recognition and photo ops with the principal beginning the second trimester. We held our first STAR Breakfast to recognize and celebrate students nominated for their excellent behavior. During the first trimester and as of November 13, 2019, Woodworth students were

awarded 1,692 STAR tickets in acknowledgement of meeting our school-wide expectations. Some students excitedly took STAR tickets home to celebrate with family, so we certainly want to acknowledge them as well.

As part of improving the culture and climate at Woodworth Elementary, we have also implemented Restorative Practices. These practices help students with discussions of difficult topics or issues, with learning how to process their own feelings, and with understanding others' feelings. We have also seen success in using these practices as part of resolving relational issues among students. We continue to ask students "What are you doing?" followed

by "What should you be doing?" and then "What will happen if you don't change your behavior?" and finally we ask students "How can you fix this?" so that they may avoid consequences.

We want to thank families for being such amazing supporters of our learning at Woodworth, specifically those who have sponsored classrooms with Scholastic books! Our Woodworth students and their reading skills benefit greatly when they have a variety of books to read at home. We have also benefited from the support of families who attended our Halloween parties and parade. Despite the rainy weather, we had a large turn out!










#### LPS PINK HAWK PROJECT


















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
#### 2019 Fall Season Sports Recap
