
Leslie Public Schools is very grateful for the many ways our stakeholders support the success of our children and our community, especially through this difficult year. There are so many positive stories the district has had bringing face-to-face education to our students. A huge thank you to our wonderful teachers, staff, families, and especially our students. I give our community so much credit on what we have accomplished this school year.

As we look forward, there are two big questions the Board of Education will be bringing to voters in 2021. The Operating Millage Renewal will be on the August 3, 2021 ballot, and a bond proposal will be on the November 2, 2021 ballot. I want to share some important points to differentiate between the two.

About once every ten years, the public gets to vote on an Operating Millage Renewal, and this is the year! This renewal contributes approximately 12% of the LPS operating budget each year. This pays for items needed to keep the schools operational each day. Such items this renewal contributes to include wages of teachers, bus drivers, food service workers, books, bus fuel, paper, computers, paint, boiler parts, and the monthly utility bill, etc. Without it, we would have to make difficult changes that will impact the district as a whole. The millage renewal will not change the taxes on your primary residence. It is a renewal on non-homestead properties only, which includes business properties and second homes in the area. Please represent LPS August 3rd.

In November, voters will have an opportunity to decide on a bond proposal. While I'm writing this, the Board of Education is considering what specifically will show up on that proposal based on the feedback received from the community forums, through the online video forms, emails, and phone calls. We look forward to continuing our dialogue with the community in regards to the improvements that make our district great.

This was a tough year for everyone, but we fought through it and had wonderful achievements in the district! I am looking forward to next school year and the exciting things to come!

Woodworth Elementary School Woodworth Elementary School has successfully completed an awesome school year; one that no one could ever have anticipated!

During the year, we tried to have as much

of the "normal" as possible, which included birthday and holiday celebrations, March is Reading Month, Spirit Week, and two school-wide STAR student celebrations. Although we were not able to invite families this year, we still celebrated STAR students during lunchtime each trimester. Students cheered for each recipient, which was very exciting!

To continue to provide excellent opportunities, the school was awarded a Building Healthy Communities grant from Wayne State University, which provided our students with specific lessons for the classroom, healthy food announcements every morning throughout the school year and health information for our newsletters and families. We also had the opportunity to develop health-centered student clubs for after school, but we were limited this year because of the health restrictions. We will be looking at actually building these student clubs next year for interested individuals. The advantage of having received this grant is that it is sustainable for the years to come, providing the school with continued access to the online resources and playground equipment for the students to use.

Another advancement Woodworth Elementary made this year was to connect with the Capital Area District Library Student Success Initiative. All students and staff now have library cards and online access to library resources. We have also arranged for our students to be able to browse the school library online and place holds on books they are interested in reading. This has allowed the school to continue circulating eBooks to students.




