Student Success Initiative Scholarship FAQs

Q: What is the Student Success Initiative Scholarship?

A: The Student Success Initiative Scholarship was created by CADL to help two graduating high school seniors, who have an SSI account, with any college-related expenses.

Q: How is the scholarship being funded?

A: The scholarship is being funded by donations through Kroger Community Rewards and a generous donation from the Capital Area Transportation Authority (CATA). **No library funds are being used to fund the scholarship.**

Q: How much is the scholarship and how many recipients will there be?

A: CADL will select two recipients, who will each receive a \$1,000 scholarship. **This is a one-time scholarship.**

Q: Who is eligible to receive an SSI Scholarship?

A: To be eligible for an SSI Scholarship, applicants must meet **all** the following criteria:

- 1. Must be a high school senior graduating this year
- 2. Must have a 2.5 or higher GPA when they apply
- 3. Must have an SSI account that has been used at least one time within the last year
- 4. Must be attending an accredited college, university or vocational school in the fall after high school graduation.

Q: What activities count as SSI accounts use?

A: Any activity that requires your library card to use the first- or every time. This includes checking out digital and physical titles, using CADL digital resources (but does not include most MeL databases) and using library public use computers.

Q: Is there anyone who isn't eligible to receive a scholarship?

A: Employees of CATA and CADL and their immediate family members (parents, stepparents, siblings, spouses, in-laws, children, stepchildren and foster children) are not eligible for this scholarship.

Q: How do I apply for an SSI Scholarship?

A: To apply for an SSI Scholarship, you must fill out the official online application and write a 500-1,000-word essay answering the question, "How would you define success?"

Q: Where can I download the official online application?

A: You can download the official online application at www.cadl.org/success.

Q: What materials do I need to submit to be considered for an SSI Scholarship?

A: You must submit **all three** of the following documents to be considered for an SSI scholarship:

- 1. Official online application
- 2. Essay
- 3. Copy of unofficial high school transcript

Q: How can I submit my application, essay and unofficial transcripts?

A: You can submit your application and accompanying materials in one of the following ways:

- 1. Email them to scholarship@cadl.org.
- 2. Mail them to Capital Area District Libraries, Attn. SSI Scholarship, 401 S. Capitol Ave. Lansing, MI 48933
- 3. Drop them off at CADL Administrative Offices (third floor of Downtown Lansing Branch) 401 S. Capitol Ave.

Q: What is the deadline to apply for the scholarship?

A: The official application, required essay and unofficial high school transcript must be received by **5 p.m. on April 14, 2023.**

Q: When can I expect to know if I received a scholarship?

A: You will be notified by CADL by June 9, 2023 if you were selected to receive a scholarship.
